SPAN 204	Intermediate Spanish	The two-semester sequence of SPAN 203/003 and SPAN 204/004 is designed to increase reading and writing skills. SPAN 293	Spanish Service Learning	Prerequisite, permission of the instructor. Service learning component for students enrolled in Spanish language courses. May not count toward the major or minor in Spanish.	LEE
SPAN 300	Advanced Grammar and Composition	Prerequisite, SPAN 260/SPAN 021 or SPAN 255/SPAN 023 or equivalent. Designed to improve writing accuracy with common points of Spanish grammar. The skill is further developed through exercises and compositions involving process- and task-oriented approaches to writing.	HUER

SPAN 310	Conversation II	Prerequisite, SPAN 260/SPAN 021 or SPAN 255/SPAN 023 or equivalent. Designed to expand speaking skills through conversational activities, discussion of authentic readings, and associated vocabulary building. Emphasis also on continued development of writing skills.
